Neighborhood Pride Day is an annual event that allows residents, landlords, and businesses of the community to work together to improve their neighborhood. Participants volunteer their time to do this work, and in doing so, help build stronger neighborhoods and improve residents' quality of life.

The event is coordinated by the Neighborhood Housing Services of Los Angeles County (NHS), whose purpose is "Establishing, Protecting and Preserving Lifelong Homeowners throughout Los Angeles County." NHS strengthens communities by connecting residents with affordable housing, by supporting local leaders, and by increasing the financial independence of families in the area. Neighborhood Pride Day allows those invested in the community to help revitalize the neighborhood. Supporters this year were encouraged to "once again show the strength and heart of Reseda coming together and working as a community."

The Discovery House is a [substance abuse treatment center](#) located in the heart of Reseda, California. Clients participate in residential treatment at the facility, and alumni of the program stay connected through an extended care program.
